REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY LAND INFORMATION SYSTEM (NPALIS)

A. INTRODUCTION

Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA) is desirous of having a modern, reliable, fast digital mapping and Land Administration System through the Establishment of the "Nigerian Ports Authority Land Information System" (NPALIS). In this regard, reputable and competent firms are invited to submit Expression of Interest (EoI) documents for the execution of this project.

B. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The scope of services shall be provided in the Request for Proposal (RFP) that will be issued to prequalified Bidders.

C. REQUIREMENT

Interested companies should submit their EOI documents in One (1) Soft Copy and Two (2) Hard Copies duly signed, paginated, separated by dividers and arranged in the order outlined hereunder:

Mandatory Requirements

- 1. Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Forms CO2/CA2 and CO7/CA7.
- Evidence of Company Tax Clearance Certificate and Audited Account for the last three (3) years (2014, 2015 & 2016), duly signed by Registered Practitioners.
- 3. Evidence of current Pension Clearance Certificate from National Pension Commission (PENCOM).
- 4. Evidence of Compliance Certificate with Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Act No. 19 of 2011.
- 5. Evidence of registration on the National Data Base of Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by the Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) or copy of interim Registration Report (IRR) as evidence of compliance with the requirement.
- 6. Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorized by the bidder.
- 7. All bids must be accompanied with a sworn affidavit disclosing that they do not have any Director who has been convicted in any Country for any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to any matter.
- 8. All bidders must accompany every bid with sworn affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA) or Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) is a former or present director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.
- Evidence of Three (3) similar projects executed in the past Ten (10) years including letters of awards, completion certificates payment etc.
- 10. Personnel registration with appropriate professional bodies.
- 11. Company profile to include names, qualifications (Evidenced by certificates) and experience of key personnel.
- 12. Evidence of Financial Capability from a reputable bank/Letter of commitment from bank.
- 13. All relevant information concerning contact, telephone numbers (preferably GSM Nos.), fax and e-mail address of firm's representative.
- 14. For Joint Venture (JV)/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided.

Note: Failure to comply with items 1-8 above will lead to disqualification of the bid.

D. SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST
