REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR CARGO SURVEY SERVICES AT LAGOS PORT COMPLEX APAPA

A. INTRODUCTION

This is to inform the general public that the Procurement Proceedings of the above-mentioned project earlier advertised as Public Notice No 3958 in the Daily Trust and Guardian of Monday 14th November 2016 as well as Federal Tenders Journal of Monday, November 14 –Sunday November 27, 2016 has been cancelled as a result of errors in the publication.

Consequently, the Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA) hereby re-advertises for reputable and competent cargo surveying companies to express interest in cargo survey services at **Lagos Port Complex, Apapa** as indicated below:

B. SCOPE OF SERVICE

The scope of Service is detailed in the Request for Proposals documents (RfP), which shall be issued, to shortlisted bidders.

C. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Interested bidders should submit their (Eoi) documents in **One (1) soft Copy and Two (2) Hard copies** duly signed paginated, separated by dividers and arranged in the order outlined hereunder:

1. Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including forms Co2/CA2 and Co7/CA7
2. Evidence of Company's Tax Clearance Certificate and Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years (2013, 2014 & 2015).
3. Evidence of Current Pension Clearance Certificate (2016) from National Pension Commission (PenCom)
4. Evidence of Current Certificate of Compliance with Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Act No. 19 of 2011
5. Evidence of Certificate of registration on the National Data Base of Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) or copy of Interim Registration Report (IRR) as evidence of compliance with the requirement
6. Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorized by the bidder
7. All bids must be accompanied with a sworn affidavit disclosing that they do not have any Director who has been convicted in any Country for any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to any matter
8. All bidders must accompany every bid with an affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA) or Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) is a former or present director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.
9. Company profile to include names, qualifications (attach Certificates) and experience of key personnel (provide evidence of experience).
10. All relevant information concerning contacts, addresses, telephones (**GSM**), fax and e-mail address of company or representative(s) must be provided.
11. For Joint Venture (JV), Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided.

Note: Failure to comply with items 1-8 above will lead to disqualification of the Eoi

D. SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

Prospective bidders are to submit One (1) Soft copy and Two (2) spiral bound hard copies of **Expression of Interest (Eoi) documents** in the order outlined above. The Eoi documents must be submitted in SEALED ENVELOPE and addressed to: **"THE SECRETARY TO THE TENDERS BOARD, NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY"** and clearly marked as **"EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR CARGO SURVEY SERVICES AT LAGOS PORT COMPLEX** specifying PUBLIC NOTICE NO: 3971 and also indicate the **LOT No desired** and dropped in the designated Tender Box located on the 1st floor of the Headquarters Building of Nigerian Ports Authority at 26/28, Marina Lagos adjacent to Lift Lobby not later than **11.00am on Thursday, 12th January 2017**. Where a bidder decides to bid for two (2) Lots, submission on each should be made separately.

All received Eoi documents will be publicly opened **immediately** after close of submission at the Conference room, 1 Joseph Street, off Marina, Lagos in the presence of the bidders or their representatives and any interested member of the public.
